With the heavyweights of Miami Art Week closing their doors, Jada 2020 will be presenting to the world the future of Miami Art Week amidst the uncertainty of the pandemic. In adherence to local COVID-19 regulations, we will be debuting for the first time in Miami a hybrid event showcasing in person and broadcasting across the internet.

Jada comes to oppose the hegemony of the international presence at Miami Art Week, and by encouraging local artists, leaders, and organizations to finally embrace the responsibility of being the cultural agents within the Miami art cosmos.

Jada invites all artists to challenge themselves to mobilize and flourish in this new normal!
